### I. COMMITTEE REPORTS

#### DIRECTORS REPORT

E. Jung reports that the decennial committed has not met yet. We will meet in the September meeting. SWSRA has not come up with a contribution number yet. They are trying to finalize it by November. Concerns have been brought up about Kostner Park and he has been in touch with the resident that voiced their concerns and the police to try to get the issues resolved.

#### **RECREATION REPORT**

J Yuska reports we hired a Athletic Supervisor Alex Pasek. T-Ball is doing a Thunderbolts game as a fundraiser type of thing for the t-ball League. We may do that next year for Day Camp. Day Camp numbers are high, and Angela is doing great. The Ice Cream Social was sold out in 20 mins.

#### MAINTENANCE REPORT

Meadow Room Door- The exterior door in the Meadow Room at the ARC has been replaced. The old door was sagging and would no longer close properly because it was no longer square. The new door has a window in it which will allow camp staff to see who is knocking on the door before opening it. The new door also has the ability to be unlocked and opened from the exterior. RTU Cleaning- Staff has taken apart and cleaned the eleven rooftop units (RTU's) at the ARC. The units need to be disassembled and cleaned every spring after the cottonwood seeds have fallen. The cotton gets caught in the compressor fins and will not allow air to flow through the unit properly. Once the compressor fins are cleaned the external filters are removed and cleaned and finally the internal filters are replaced. This year there seemed to be an exceptional amount of cottonwood seeds and we had to clean a few units more than once. Memorial Painting- Staff have started doing some painting around Memorial Park. We started with the exterior painted portions of the concession stand. We will also be painting the dugouts at Howie Minas Field and the picnic shelter on the west side of the park. We purchased some scaffolding through PDRMA's Ladder Alternate Grant Program to help with completing the projects. Speed Bumps- Staff have installed additional speed bumps on the north side of the ARC parking lot. Staff noticed that cars continue to drive through the parking lot at a high rate of speed and thought the speed bumps could help. So far people do seem to be going slower through the parking lot because they eighter slow down to go over the bumps or slow down to do everything in their power to go around them, either way they are slowing down.
